The organizing committee reserves the right to reschedule breeds according to the number of entered dogs and breeds can be moved to another day. However, all lure coursing for one breed per event must take place on the same day (§4.14.2). The team leader of every country will be informed about rescheduling at the latest 8 days after the closing date.

Veterinary control

For dogs competing Thursday: Wednesday from 13:00

For dogs competing Friday: Thursday from 10:00

For dogs competing Saturday: Friday from 10:00 For dogs competing Sunday: Saturday from 10:00

Please note that you need to bring your dog's license book to the first veterinary control. Dogs under 2 years and over 6 years in each day must be at the veterinary control

30 minutes after the first run.

Identifications

The dog must have a readable microchip or readable tattoo.

Coursing distances

For Cirneco dell'Etna, Italian Sighthound and Whippet: 600 - 800 meters.

For all other sighthound breeds: 800 - 1000 meters.

Small variations of the above distances are tolerated. (§4.10.2)

Terrain & ground

Four fields on grass/pasture.

Type of lure

Lure pulled over pulleys.

Admission

CACIL class and CSS class, FCI regulations §1.4, §4.2, §4.6, §4.7, §4.9

- Maximum 6 dogs per country per breed and gender in total
- Both classes are separated by gender if there are sufficient males and females (6+6)
- A dog can only be entered in one class
- To be entered any sighthound must have completed the last two lure coursing events before the deadline of the entry without disqualification
- A disqualification between the entry closing date and the date of the championship precludes participation.
- Qualification runs completed before the age limit set forth in §1.4.2 is reached are invalid.
- The FCI European Lure Coursing Champion 2022 and CSS World Winner Lure Coursing 2022 can defend their titles in the class of their 2023 license (CSS or CACIL) and can be entered in addition to the maximum permissible participants.
- Stud book required according to FCI regulations § 4.6.1.

CACIL allocation CACIL will be awarded according to the FCI regulations §5. When the National Organiza-

tion on the registration form indicates that the dog has got a CACIL-license and applies

for the CACIL, this is accepted as evidence.

National certificates National certificates will be awarded per breed, class and gender. To be awarded a

national certificates, the dog has to achieve at least 75% of the maximal points.

Other information

- In the start we say GO and give you a tap on the back.
- There will be yellow signs in front of the paddocs that shows the number of the race that the starters have called for to come and be checked.
- There will be speakers near the campsite were the starters call the number of the race that must come to the paddocs.
- The starters will only call your dogs race number 3 times so please be on time.
- For track 1 it takes 4 minutes to walk.
- For track 2 it takes 8 minutes to walk.
- For track 3 it takes 12 minutes to walk.
- There will be a car at two of the fields standing ready if an accident occurs with any dog.
- The RED CROSS will work at the sight to help participants in need.
- The use of a muzzle is compulsory for all breeds.
- Red and white jackets are compulsory; text, signs or other attributes that can be used to identify are not allowed on the jackets.
- Country flags or signal-/ bright colors on the dogs' leg-tapes are not allowed.
- In case of an eventual cancellation of the event, beyond the organizer's responsibility, no liability will be taken.
- For dogs not competing and need help from our vets a cost of 25€
 (+ cost for medicine) will be payed of the owner in cash on site.

Doping and other inappropriate measures

Participating of ill or injured dogs is not permitted. Furthermore the dog must not be affected in any forbidden way, i.e. been subjected to measures aimed at inappropriately altering their appearance, performance or reactions/character, or intended to conceal signs of injury or illness.

It is the obligation of the person responsible for a dog to ascertain how a specific treatment or other measure may affect the eligibility of that dog to take part in a trial, competition or show.

There will be doping tests. The person responsible for the dog is obliged to make that dog in question available for testing and for any further examination resulting from the test.

Doping tests will be executed according to the national doping regulations and FCI regulations § 1.9.

Neutered male dogs/bitches

Male dog that has been neutered by medical treatment or by chip treatment is not allowed to take part in trials, competitions and shows. Exemption to take part is not available.

Bitches that has been neutered by continuously medical treatment is allowed to a general exemption to take part in trials, competitions and shows. (National regulations)













SKK vaccination regulations

The vaccination regulations adopted by Svenska Kennelklubben apply at dog shows and trials. To be eligible for participation the dog must have an up-to-date distemper vaccination.

Distemper vaccination

Participating dogs must have been vaccinated against distemper in accordance with the following:

- Dogs under the age of one (1) year: at the age of at least ten (10) weeks.
- Dogs over the age of one (1) year: the dog must be vaccinated at the age of at least ten (10) months, and not more than four (4) years ago.

Parvo vaccination

Svenska Kennelklubben recommends that all dogs are vaccinated against parvovirus.

Parainfluenza

Svenska Kennelklubben also recommends that participating dogs are vaccinated against parainfluenza (kennel cough).

Rabies vaccination

Please observe that titer test instead of vaccinations is not valid in Sweden.

Bringing dogs into Sweden

To bring a dog into Sweden follow the regulations of the European Union (EU). Detailed information about the regulations can be found on the Swedish Board of Agriculture's website (Jordbruksverket), www.sjv.se.

Non-Swedish participates are responsible for obtaining information on the rules and regulations for reimporting into the owner's native country.

Border control on bringing a dog into Sweden

When bringing a dog into Sweden, customs should be notified when crossing the border. Detailed regulations can be found at the Swedish Customs website (Tullverket), www. tullverket.se.

Deworming

Is possible to a cost of 10€/dog. 3-5 dogs 25€. You need to bring your own tablets, these are not available at our yet.
